ISA Standards & Practices Award 2008

On the 12th of October Ms. Scholten won the ISA Standards & Practices Department Award for her outstanding technical contributions in the development of ISA-TR88.95.01-2008, Using ISA-88 and ISA-95 Together.

Raymond D. Molloy Award

This award is presented by the ISA Publications Department to the best-selling ISA author of the previous year. This award was given to Bianca Scholten for her book "The Road to Integration: A Guide to Applying the ISA-95 Standard in Manufacturing", which sold the most units of any book published by ISA in 2007.

Thomas G. Fisher Award of Excellence

Ms. Scholten is also the recipient of the Thomas G. Fisher Award of Excellence for a standards-based reference publication. This award is presented annually by the ISA publications Department and ISA Standards and Practices Department. Ms. Scholten's book "The Road to Integration: A Guide to Applying the ISA-95 Standard in Manufacturing", has been selected as the best new standards-based book of 2007.
